

## Pennant Banner

These banners will be included in the Bed Rest Bags™ and NICU Napsacks™ for decoration

### YOU WILL NEED:

Scrapbook paper, cardstock, felt

String, yarn, twine, ribbon

Hole punch

Pennant Template

Letter Template

Paper cutter or scissors

Glue, fabric glue, hot glue or needle & thread

Markers, paint pens, etc. may be used for lettering

**\*Optional\*** You may use pre-cut letters, stickers, home craft décor etc.

### DIRECTIONS:

1. Download pattern and print.
2. Cut out pennant template.
3. Use template to trace pennant on each piece of paper or felt.
4. Using the paper cutter or scissors, cut out each pennant flag.
5. Using the hole punch, you will need to punch out two holes in each flag.
6. Determine how long your string will need to be, cut to that length and thread through each hole. Remember to leave room on each end to hang the banner. You may knot the ends to create a loop to hang.
7. If you are using felt or fabric you will have to cut small holes for the string, yarn, ribbon or twine to go through.

### LETTERING:

1. Select which inspirational phrase you would like to create from the list below.
2. Download the lettering template if you wish to use our letter options.
3. Cut out the lettering pattern.
4. Trace the pattern onto the paper or felt you would like to use.
5. Cut out the letters.
6. Attach the lettering on the pennant banner using glue, fabric glue, hot glue or stitching.
